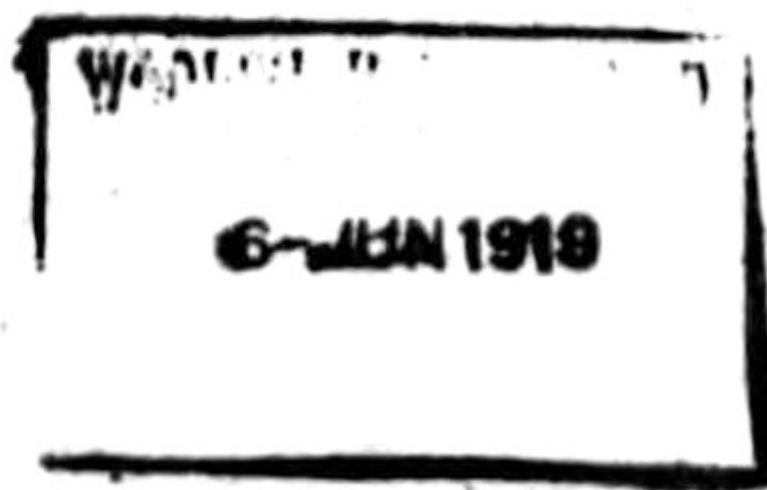

OPINION OF THE EXAMINING MEDICAL OFFICER.

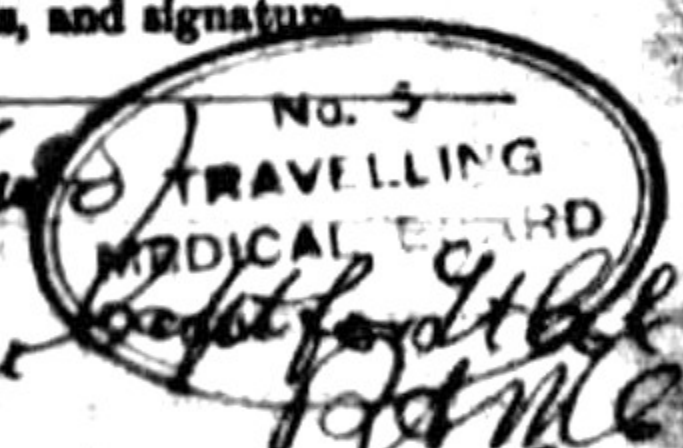
